

Hail Adjuster Qualification Exam

The Bylaws of the Hail Insurance Council of Saskatchewan require that anyone acting as a Crop Hail Adjuster must be licensed.

A hail adjuster qualification exam comprised of 50 multiple choice questions has been developed for licensing purposes.

The hail adjuster exam is primarily based on information found in the Crop Hail Adjustment Manual however necessary information will also be found in relevant sections of the Saskatchewan Insurance Act and the Hail Insurance Council of Saskatchewan Bylaws.

It is recommended that exam applicants become familiar with the above documents and obtain basic adjuster experience in the field prior to attempting the crop hail adjuster examination.

Please refer to the following material when preparing to write the Hail Adjuster Exam.

1. Crop Hail Adjustment Manual

Adjuster exam applicants should pay specific attention to the introductory sections of the manual including the General Adjusting Procedures section and those sections of the manual which are specific to; cereal crops, canola and mustard, flax, peas, chickpeas and lentils.
