Insurance Warning Issued

Government and insurance industry officials are warning Saskatchewan residents to be careful about purchasing insurance online at the www.quickeasyinsure.com address.

That warning was provided Friday in a news release issued jointly by the province's Superintendent of Insurance and by the Insurance Councils of Saskatchewan.

The warning indicated that consumers are not dealing with a licensed Canadian insurance firm if they do business at the [quickeasyinsure.com](http://www.quickeasyinsure.com) business.

Consumers are also being warned that they will have no chance of recovering their money, if the quick and easy insurance is not provided as advertised.

In addition consumers are being warned that providing a social insurance number or banking information to the Quick Easy insurance firm could increase the risk of identity theft.

While the company purports to be operated by a local brokerage firm, government and industry officials say the computer site is actually located in St. Petersburg, Russia.
