Important Update: Continuing Education Credit Hour Change Effective July 1, 2024

The Life Insurance Council of Saskatchewan has made an amendment to Chapter IX, Section 9(3) and (4) of the Life Insurance Council of Saskatchewan Bylaw regarding Continuing Education (CE) credit hours.

Effective July 1, 2024, the approved CE credit hour minimum has been revised from 1 hour to 0.5 hours per continuing education course. This change aims to enhance the flexibility and accessibility of continuing education for all licensees covered under the Life Insurance Council of Saskatchewan.

Please note that any 0.5-hour CE courses taken prior to July 1, 2024, will not be accepted for credit. Only courses completed on or after the effective date will be eligible under the new bylaw amendment.

Chapter IX, Section 9 (3) and (4) of the Bylaw:

Part IX
Continuing Education

9-1 Rules for qualifying for continuing education

- (3) 30 minutes of instruction is equal to 0.5 hours of continuing education credit.
- (4) Courses less than 30 minutes in duration do not qualify for continuing education credit.
