Open Book Bylaw Exam

Individuals residing in Saskatchewan that wish to obtain an insurance or adjuster licence are required to pass the bylaw exam before submitting an application for licence to the Insurance Councils of Saskatchewan (Council). This requirement has been in effect for many years.

The bylaw exam has always been offered as a closed-book exam. The bylaw exam will be offered as an open-book exam for applicants registering for an exam sitting effective the date identified by each organization listed below.

March 23, 2015	Association of Canadian Travel Agencies (ACTA)

Each applicant will receive a copy of the bylaws at the exam sitting. The applicant must hand in the bylaws, exam and answer sheet prior to leaving the exam facility.

The bylaw exam focuses on the obligations and conduct of a licensed insurance agent, salesperson or adjuster.

Please note no changes have been made to the questions on the bylaw exam. Exam questions are taken from the following bylaw sections so ensure you have the most current copy available:

- Bylaw 2 – Licenses
- Bylaw 3 – Education requirements
- Bylaw 5 – Register and Licensing
- Bylaw 8 – Misconduct
- Bylaw 9 – Incompetence
- Schedules - Specific to the class of licence you are applying for.

Individuals applying for an All Classes other than Life, Restricted Auto, Restricted Travel or Adjuster Representative Licence will utilize the General Insurance Council Bylaws.

Individuals applying for a Life and A&S; or A&S licence will utilize the Life Insurance Council Bylaws.
