

Overview of changes to National Crop Insurance Services Crop Hail Procedures that appear in the Canadian Crop Hail Manual.

Flax Factors

These factors were taken out of the manual a few years back, the reason for the removal is unclear, the factors in this chart are used to adjust currently but they are not presented in the manual so we are bringing them back for adjuster clarity and consistency.

Alfalfa Survey Sheet

This is an Alfalfa survey sheet example copy for the Alfalfa Forage section. This goes along with the addition of the forage section back to the Alfalfa section in 2017. It is a Survey sheet that reflects Forage adjusting procedures for accuracy, compared to trying to adapt the seed loss survey sheet that reflects Alfalfa Seed adjusting procedures.

Corn Silage and Grazing

The adjusting procedures currently address strictly future seed loss in corn due to hail. The addition of this Corn Silage and Grazing to the manual is reflective to the bulk of corn crops that are grown in the Prairies, which is corn for Silage or Grazing not for seed. It addresses and puts loss percentages to all parts of the plant that is of value to Corn Silage and Grazing growers, not just seed a seed loss value due to hail.
